MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED

Lori Cable welcomed everyone to January's meeting. Dave talked about the new math classes we are adding to our schedule for next year. Math 1030 and 1040 are going to be added along with Mathematics of Personal Finance. Trina Ward has talked to some other teachers in the district and is hoping to get some more guidelines for 1040. Trina will be meeting with UVU to talk to them about it. It was also suggested that the counselors go into our math classes to discuss which concurrent enrollment math classes count for which majors.

Accreditation will be coming up next year. Different surveys will be going out to our community to help with that. February through March of next year will probably be when they come. School Community Council will be involved with that.

Dave wanted to know what the council's opinion was on how the Chromebooks were working. He has a parent who is upset that the student is not using his Chromebook for homework but for games. Everyone on the council felt that the Chromebooks are working great and that it should be the

They are also giving the students back their practice ACT scores and explaining the importance of the test. Counselors are also promoting scholarships and getting ready for registration next month.
