MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED

HEIDI WELCOMED THE COUNSEL TO THE MEETING AND SHARLA BARBER WENT OVER MINUTES FROM DECEMBER'S MEETING. LUKE ISLEY MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES AND LORI CABLE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR.
