## **MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED**

TODAY'S MEETING STARTED AT 3:00 PM AND MEMBERS WERE WELCOMED BY THE CHAIR, LORI CABLE. HEIDI CONWAY PRESENTED INFORMATION TO THE COUNCIL THAT SHE WAS GIVEN AT THE DISTRICT SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING AT THE ADVANCED LEARNING CENTER. MUCH OF THIS INFORMATION INCLUDED NEW LEGISLATIVE BILLS AND NEW SCHOOL BUILDING INFORMATION AND UPDATES.

SHARLA BARBER WENT OVER MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY'S MEETING. JAMIE BRANCH MOTIONED FOR THE MINUTES TO BE APPROVED AND HEIDI CONWAY SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL COUNCIL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR.

DAVE MCKEE WELCOMED AND INTRODUCED MATT CHRISTENSEN WHO WILL BE SPANISH FORK HIGH SCHOOL'S NEW PRINCIPAL NEXT YEAR. HE WILL BE ATTENDING THE REST OF THIS YEAR'S SCC MEETINGS AND WILL BE POPPING IN AND OUT OF THE SCHOOL AS MUCH AS HE CAN. MATT IS EXCITED TO BE A PART OF SPANISH FORK HIGH SCHOOL AGAIN AND THANKFUL FOR THE OPPORTUNITY.

NEXT DAVE HANDED OUT COPIES OF THE PROPOSED SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR

everyone to look over. He explained each one and why it was needed and what he hoped it would accomplish. There were 3 goals which included: Visible Learning, interventions for student learning, and technology in the classroom. Jamie Branch made a motion to approve the school improvement plan and Heidi Conway seconded the motion. All members approved.

Dave then handed out the trust lands proposal sheet for the 2019-2020 school year. There is \$15,000.00 of carry over funds that will be added to the total requested of \$186,094.00. Some of what was requested was: teacher salary, summer collaboration for math teachers, Latinos in action, and Chromebooks. The council thought it looked good and Matt Christensen mentioned that we would work more on it next month.

Matt Christensen spoke to the council a little bit regarding some changes moving forward. There is talk of a bill passing that will eliminate required textbook fees from students. He is concerned about this and wanted the council to know that we need to start planning and saving for this if it does pass. He also mentioned that he would soon be meeting with other administrators and district personnel to discuss streamlining fees throughout the district.

SHARLA BARBER UPDATED THE COUNCIL ON HAPPENINGS IN THE COUNSELING OFFICE. REGISTRATION IS COMPLETE AT ALL GRADE LEVELS. COUNSELORS WILL BE PULLING IN STRAGGLERS OR STUDENTS WHO WERE ABSENT. COUNSELORS ARE ALSO WORKING WITH SENIORS RIGHT NOW ON SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS. THEY ARE ALSO FOLLOWING THEIR SENIORS VERY CLOSELY TO MAKE SURE THAT THEY HAVE WHAT THEY NEED TO HAVE DONE FOR GRADUATION. A CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT NIGHT AT SF WAS HELD AS WELL AS A PARENT NIGHT FOR JUNIOR HIGH PARENTS. BOTH EVENTS WERE VERY WELL ATTENDED. TWO OF OUR COUNSELORS ARE HOLDING HOPE WEEK NEXT WEEK AND WILL BE HAVING DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES EACH DAY TO PROMOTE WELL BEING AND SCHOOL WIDE SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS.
