## **MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED**

Lori cable welcomed everyone to the meeting. Sharla Barber read minutes from January. Community members gave great feedback on the college tour for our Juniors. Ashley Ortiz also thought it was very worthwhile and is now receiving information from colleges regarding scholarships and admissions.

Dave passed out School Improvement Plan Goals for the 2018-19 school year and explained the 3 goals that he would like implemented. One of the goals focuses a lot on John Hattie and Visible Learning. He wants to send 10 people to John Hattie's training this summer. The teachers will then come back and share the information they learned with the rest of the staff each month. Heidi Conway asked the teachers to give her some examples of visible learning and how they are using it in their classroom. Lori Jacobson and Trina Ward explained some of their processes.

KRISTEN WILLIAMS, OUR LIBRARIAN, QUESTIONED THE ABC DATABASE THAT COST \$1,300.00. SHE IS GOING TO CHECK WITH OTHERS TO SEE IF THEY ARE STILL USING IT. THAT COULD BE TAKEN OFF OF THE BUDGET.

DAVE EXPLAINED THAT WE ARE OVER OUR BUDGET BUT IF WE ARE ABLE TO TAKE OFF THE DATABASE MONEY IT WILL BE CLOSER AND HE WILL BE ABLE TO COME UP WITH THE REST OF THE MONEY SOMEWHERE ELSE.

THE COUNCIL TALKED ABOUT IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE SCHOOL AND WHAT NEEDS TO BE IMPROVED. THEY ALSO TALKED ABOUT THE ATTENDANCE POLICY AND GIVING DETENTION CREDIT AND HOW AND WHEN IT SHOULD BE USED.

DAVE BROUGHT UP THE STUDENT WALK OUT DAY THAT IS BEING SPREAD ON SOCIAL MEDIA IN SUPPORT OF THE SCHOOL SHOOTINGS AND HOW WE ARE GOING TO APPROACH IT AT SCHOOL. WE ARE GOING TO HOLD SCHOOL AS NORMAL AND MARK KIDS AS SLUFFS IF THEY WALK OUT OF THE CLASSROOM. THEIR PARENTS WILL NEED TO EXCUSE THEM IF THEY WANT THEIR STUDENTS WALKING OUT.

LORI MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE TRUST LANDS BUDGET AND THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN. JILL PERRINS APPROVED THE MOTION AND HEIDI CONWAY SECONDED IT. ALL OF THE COUNCIL WAS IN FAVOR.
