SHARLA BARBER THEN WENT OVER THE MINUTES FROM LAST MONTHS MEETING. JAMIE BRANCH MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES AND WENDY LEFEVRE SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR.

DAVE MCKEE PASSED OUT THE FINAL TRUST LANDS REPORT FOR THE 2017-18 YEAR. HE WENT THROUGH THE SPREADSHEET AGAIN TALKING ABOUT FUNDING AND WHAT WAS USED FOR TEACHER PAY. THERE WERE NO QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS FROM THE COUNCIL.

STUDENTS IN ATTENDANCE AT THE MEETING COMMENTED ON THE GOOD AND BAD OF THE BOOTCAMP AND ALSO HOW THE ACT PREP CLASS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY HAS BEEN HELPFUL FOR THEM. DAVE MCKEE SAID THAT HE DID GET A REPORT BACK FROM THE STATE THAT SHOWS OUR STUDENTS ACT SCORES AS A WHOLE IMPROVING EACH YEAR.
