## **MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED**

LORI CABLE WELCOMED THE COUNCIL TO TODAY'S MEETING. SHARLA BARBER WENT OVER MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER'S MEETING. HEIDI CONWAY MOTIONED FOR THE MINUTES TO BE APPROVED AND ERIN MUIRBROOK SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR.

SOME OF THE SPANISH FORK HIGH SCHOOL CLUBS FROM LAST MONTHS MEETING WERE NOT APPROVED FOR CLUB RUSH WEEK. THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CLUBS WERE GIVEN ANOTHER CHANCE TO GET ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR THE COUNCIL TO REVIEW THEIR REQUEST AGAIN THIS MONTH. THE CO-ED SPORTS CLUB, MOUNTAIN BIKE CLUB, AND THE PICKLEBALL CLUB WERE REVIEWED AGAIN TODAY AND WERE APPROVED. HEIDI CONWAY MADE THE MOTION FOR THE CLUBS TO BE APPROVED, TIFFANY BEUS SECONDED THE MOTION, AND ALL COUNCIL WAS IN FAVOR.

THAT WAS OFFERED LAST WEDNESDAY. COUNSELORS ARE FINISHING UP MEETING WITH EVERY SINGLE SENIOR AND HAVE BEEN TO SEVERAL CONFERENCES INCLUDING SUICIDE PREVENTION, ESSENTIALS TRAINING, AND A COUPLE OF DIFFERENT COLLEGE UNIVERSITY CONFERENCES.

HEIDI CONWAY ASKED HOW WE FELT THE ANXIETY FILM WENT. LATINOS IN ACTION STUDENTS THAT WERE IN THE ROOM SPOKE ABOUT HOW IT HELPED THEM UNDERSTAND THEIR FRIENDS WHO HAD BEEN DEALING WITH ANXIETY. COUNSELORS SAW ABOUT 4 STUDENTS THAT DAY THAT WANTED TO TALK ABOUT THEIR ANXIETY OR PANIC ATTACKS. COUNSELORS ALSO GOT A FEW REFERRALS FOR THE NEW ANXIETY GROUP THAT THEY WILL BE HOLDING STARTING ON MONDAY.

LORI CABLE THANKED EVERYONE FOR COMING AND MADE A MOTION TO END THE MEETING. HEIDI CONWAY SECONDED THE MOTION AND ALL WERE IN FAVOR. THE MEETING ENDED AT 4:01
