MATTERS PROPOSED, DISCUSSED, OR DECIDED

SHARLA BARBER WELCOMED THE COUNCIL FOR 2016-17. SHE ALSO INTRODUCED THE NEW MEMBERS.

DAVE MCKEE ASKED ABOUT NOMINATIONS FOR CHAIRPERSON FOR THE 2016-17 YEAR. DEON YOUD NOMINATED TIFFANY BEUS FOR CHAIR AND NO OTHER NOMINATIONS WERE GIVEN. ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR OF TIFFANY BEUS AS THE CHAIR FOR THE 2016-17 SCC. CO-CHAIR NOMINATION WAS GIVEN FROM DEON YOUD WHO NOMINATED LUKE ISLEY FOR CO-CHAIR. ALL WERE IN FAVOR.

SHARLA BARBER GAVE THE COUNCIL A LIST OF STATE TRAININGS FOR SCHOOL COMMUNITY MEMBERS AND ASKED THAT THEY TRY TO ATTEND ONE AND REPORT BACK.

DAVE AND SHARLA EXPLAINED TO NEW MEMBERS WHAT A SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL'S ROLE IS AND HOW IT IS UTILIZED.

DAVE EXPLAINED WHAT HAPPENED WITH THE FINAL TRUST LANDS MONEY. HE HAD TO CHANGE THE VERBIAGE ON GOAL #2 IN ORDER TO USE THE FUNDS THE WAY WE HAD INITIALLY ALLOTTED IT.

DAVE MCKEE GAVE THE CLUB APPLICATIONS THAT HE HAD ALREADY RECEIVED TO MEMBERS ON THE COUNCIL TO LOOK OVER. HE WANTED TO MAKE SURE THEY WERE APPROVED BEFORE THE STUDENTS STARTED ADVERTISING FOR CLUB RUSH WEEK. THE CELIBACY CLUB WAS PUT ON HOLD. MATT BARBER UNVEILED THE SFHS APP THAT HE HAS BEEN WORKING ON GETTING FOR THE LAST FEW YEARS. IT SHOULD BE OUT IN THE NEXT 10 DAYS. HE EXPLAINED HOW GOOD IT IS GOING TO BE FOR LOCAL BUSINESSES AND ALSO FOR THE STUDENTS AND COMMUNITY. WE WILL BE THE FIRST HIGH SCHOOL IN UTAH COUNTY TO HAVE IT BUT 4 SCHOOLS IN SALT LAKE ARE USING THE SAME PROGRAM AND ARE HAVING GREAT SUCCESS.

MATT BARBER BROUGHT UP THE ISSUE WITH THE SOUND SYSTEM OUT ON THE FOOTBALL FIELD. DAVE SAID THERE IS NOTHING WRONG WITH THE SYSTEM. IT NEEDS TO STAY AT A CERTAIN LEVEL AND IT WILL WORK JUST FINE. THE PEOPLE WHO ARE WORKING IT NEED TO TURN IT DOWN SO THAT IT DOESN'T CUT OUT. MATT IS GOING TO HAVE SOMEONE LOOK AT THE SYSTEM TO SEE IF WE CAN SOMEHOW SET IT SO THAT IT DOESN'T HAPPEN ANYMORE.
