

Dear Spanish Fork High Community,

Spanish Fork High is committed to the safety and health of students and staff. We are acting on the latest information regarding the coronavirus from the Utah Health Department, Nebo School District, and the State of Utah. We will be implementing the following to reduce the risk of spread of infection:

- Custodial staff will focus on contact points to clean and disinfect
- Teachers will use disinfectant spray or wipes to clean classrooms throughout the day
- Good hygiene practices will be implemented and encouraged
- Large gathering such as assemblies will be suspended at least until March 30, this may extend beyond March 30th as we are updated continually from the Utah County Health Department.
- UHSAA has suspended all athletic events beginning Monday, March 16, for a period of at least two weeks.

Preventive measure that should be taken:

- Stay home when you are sick. Stay home for at least 24 hours after you no longer have a fever or symptoms of a fever without the use of fever-reducing medicines.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue, and then dispose of the tissue and clean your hands immediately.
- Limit close contact with people who are sick.
