

NC Citizenship Overview

In order to graduate from SFHS, a student must acquire BOTH Academic & Citizenship credit in each academic class in which they enroll (see Nebo School District Policy IKF). Students will not earn citizenship credit if they earn an “F” in a class academically.

Each student is awarded 100 citizenship points at the beginning of each term for each class. To earn credit in Citizenship, a student must keep or acquire at least 45 citizenship points per class. Points are based upon the following scale:

Important Points:

- If a student does not receive an S or N in Citizenship, they do not receive Citizenship credit for that course and must make up the citizenship credit.
- During the current term, students should regain lost points with the teacher in which they are missing Citizenship credit; they can also regain points by attending detention.
- For points lost due to classroom behavior issues, the student must work with the teacher to regain those points.
- **Prearranged** family vacations and medical absences do not count against the Excused Absence limit of five.
- Any absences/tardies for which the parent of a student on NC Status does not feel their student should owe can be appealed following the district appeals process.

In order to participate in any extra-curricular activity, including field trips, the student cannot be earning an NC in Citizenship at the time of the activity.
