Summary of Spanish Fork High's TSSA Plan:

For the 2023-2024 school year, SFHS has two goals that we are focusing on. The goals are:

- Goal #1: The percentage of students performing on grade level or making progress on end of level assessments will increase in language arts/reading, math, science, and other subjects.
 - Measurement: ACT scores, Utah Aspire Plus Scores, AP scores, CE scores, CTE scores, Framework scores.
- Goal #2: SFHS will increase our inclusivity opportunities by focusing on differentiation and diversity.
 - Measurement: Number of students in the Latinos in Action Class, and our ESL class will increase.

We are also using our TSSA funds to help us achieve these goals. Our TSSA money will be used to do the following:

- Hire Tier 3 student advocates
- Purchase chromebooks
- Provide teacher professional development in math, science, and english
- Pay for our Latinos in Action Club

We believe that using funds to hire student advocates will help us reach our target student group and help them grow. These advocates work with students who have academic, attendance, or other school related needs. They help support these students and serve as an ally for their success. Purchasing Chromebooks ensures that each one of our students has a device to carry out our 1-1 initiative. Each one of our students is provided a Chromebook to use for school work throughout the entire year. Using these funds for PD opportunities in our core subject areas helps us make sure that the most effective teaching and learning is taking place in these classes. Funding our Latinos in Action Club helps us increase our inclusivity and provides wonderful opportunities for our diverse learners.
